It is important to note that ACCCT is not a committee of the WCIO. Although sharing a similar membership, the WCIO and ACCCT are separate organizations.

One of the primary products of ACCCT is its Bureau Entry and Edit Package (BEEP). BEEP is a software package that permits insurance companies and others to enter and edit statistical information that is converted into the WCIO WCSTAT format.

Among several projects, ACCCT is contemplating a software package similar to BEEP for policies. The project is called Policy Entry and Edit Package (PEEP).
